

Oregon GED Certificate or GED Transcript Request

Thank you for requesting an Oregon GED Certificate or GED Transcript, before you move forward please consider the following information to help us better understand how we can best help you with your request:

- Oregon passed a law (ORS 332.114 Issuance of diplomas to veterans), allowing eligible veterans to earn their high school diploma if they served in the Armed Forces of the United States during specific time frames. If you want to know if you are eligible, please call the Oregon Department of Education and contact Barbara Zeal at (503) 947-5727 or barbara.zeal@state.or.us, or click the link for more information on eligibility https://www.oregonlegislature.gov/bills_laws/ors/ors332.html, otherwise proceed with your request.
- If you earned your GED through Job Corps during the late 60's or throughout the 70's some students earned their GED through the federal guidelines of passing their GED with a score of 35 and others met the Oregon guidelines score of 40 to earn them an Oregon GED certificate. If you are not sure what score you earned, please contact the national Job Corps Office at, (415) 625-2600 or go on their website http://www.jobcorps.gov/contact/san_francisco.aspx we may not have you in our system.

What do students need to be aware of?

- If, based upon official documentation from Job Corps, a student's records show that he/she only met the Federal standards (35) cut score, the individual will not be issued an Oregon GED certificate but will be officially informed that the documentation from Job Corps serves as proof that the GED has been earned.
- All GED graduates who scored a 40 may or may not be in our system but with proof of score from Job Corps national office will be eligible to earn an Oregon GED Certificate.
